The construction works of the new road to the Parikkala-Syvaoro border crossing are progressing rapidly in the Republic of Karelia, Russia. The construction began last autumn and the road will be ready for use already in the summer. As a result, the road will provide a new route to Finland for Russian travellers, but that requires the development of the Parikkala-Syvaoro border crossing into an international crossing point.

- It will be agreed at the level of the presidents and foreign ministers, but here in the region we make it possible to do the final decision about the international crossing point Parikkala-Syvaoro, said the Regional Mayor of the Regional Council of South Karelia, Matti Viialainen.
